- 1. The Board has no objection to proposed amendments to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 8, RPC 8.3(c) and R. 10, RJC 2.15 and RJC 2.16(A).
- 2. The Board supports the Tennessee Judicial Conference's efforts to assist sitting Tennessee judges with personal and professional matters; however, some clarification regarding the proposed program might be helpful prior to implementation. For instance, defining the relationship, if any, between the Tennessee Retired Judges Confidential Assistance Program and the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program would be informative.
- 3. The Board respectfully suggests language that volunteer retired judges providing confidential assistance shall be immune from civil suit.
