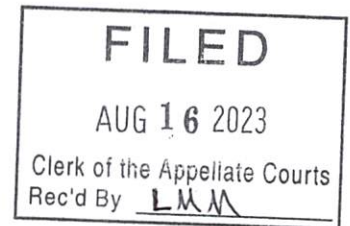

ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Board of Judicial Conduct (“Board”) upon notice from District Attorney General Pro Tem Barry P. Staubus that on August 14, 2023, Judge Daniel G. Boyd, who serves as the Juvenile Court Judge for Hawkins County, Tennessee, was indicted on three counts of forgery, a Class E felony, under Tennessee Code Annotated section 39-14-114. Judge Boyd was also charged with one count of criminal simulation, a Class E felony, under Tennessee Code Annotated section 39-14-115, and one count of bribing a witness, a Class C felony, under Tennessee Code Annotated section 39-16-107.

Tennessee Code Annotated section 17-5-303(g) provides that upon the filing of an indictment, presentment, or information charging a judge with a felony under the law of any state or under federal law, the Board may immediately place the judge on interim suspension. In this instance, the Board has determined that the public interest and proper administration of justice warrants placing Judge Boyd on interim suspension until further orders of the Board.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Judge Boyd is suspended effective immediately upon the filing of this order. During this term of suspension, Judge Boyd is prohibited from exercising any judicial power or authority, including, but not limited to, holding court, issuing subpoenas, setting or resetting cases, issuing warrants, setting or changing bonds, administering oaths, or issuing oral or written rulings in any matter. This suspension shall remain effective until further orders of the Board.
