

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Notwithstanding the provisions of any previous Administrative Order to the contrary, the following modified docket schedule is hereby adopted and will remain in place through March 1, 2021 unless rescinded, amended or extended by further Order. Beginning December 14, 2020:

1. All criminal trials and settlements for persons that are out on bond and are already set will remain on date set unless otherwise continued. All new trial dates will be set on or after March 1, 2021. All Motions for Continuance for trials set prior to March 1<sup>st</sup> will be liberally granted.
2. All juvenile matters except for delinquency cases will be heard by video. It will be the responsibility of each respective attorney to coordinate between their clients and the Court. Prior to December 14<sup>th</sup> information will be sent to the Bar regarding instructions on how to log in with each Court. Exception may be made on a case by case basis by each individual Juvenile Judge.
3. The 10:30 criminal arraignment docket will be heard in Courtroom 305.
4. The orders of protection docket will be split into three sections: 9:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Anyone who would like to appear by WebEx will need to notify the clerk in advance.
5. Docket calls will be at 10:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. Attorney that would like appear on behalf of their client should do so by WebEx unless otherwise in Court for a Trial or other in person requirement.
6. The Civil docket will be limited to 100 cases per setting.

This order is effective upon entry and shall remain in effect pending further Orders of the Court.
