DISSENTING OPINION

_____I respectfully dissent. The Committee opines that a judge may prepare and transmit a personal letter on private stationery to friends and/or acquaintances of the judge, promoting the candidacy of another judge. The Committee requires a disclaimer be placed in each letter that such written endorsement should not be publicly disseminated to others or otherwise published in a manner resulting in a public endorsement. The written correspondence is for personal and private consideration only.

It is my opinion that if a judge must put a disclaimer upon private correspondence in order to protect himself/herself from possible breaches of the Code of Judicial Ethics under Cannon 2(B) and Cannon 5(A)(11)(b), the judge should not write the correspondence in the first place.
