ORDER

Upon consideration of the application for permission to appeal of Carl Allen and the record before us, the application is granted. In addition to the issues raised in the application, the Court would like the parties to address how, under either Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-39-201, et, seq., or any published regulations: 1) the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) classifies out-of-state sexual offenders for registration on the Tennessee Sexual Offender Registry; 2) the TBI notifies offenders of changes in classification; 3) and an offender, once classified or re-classified, can challenge a classification. The Court also invites interested parties and individuals to file briefs as *amicus curiae* in compliance with Tenn. R. App. P. 31. The Clerk is directed to place this matter on the docket for oral argument upon the completion of briefing.
