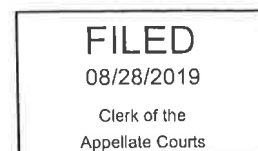

ORDER

It appears to the Court that each of the seven members of the Judicial Ethics Committee has completed at least one four-year term pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 10A.1(c). To provide for an orderly transition, the Court hereby re-appoints the following judges:

John Campbell - Trial Judge from West Tennessee - term shall expire December 31, 2020.

Tammy Harrington - Trial Judge from East Tennessee - term shall expire December 31, 2021.

Tim Irwin - Juvenile Judge - term shall expire December 31, 2021.

Betty Thomas Moore - General Sessions Judge - term shall expire December 31, 2022.

Paul Plant - Municipal Judge - term shall expire December 31, 2020.

It appears to the Court that the terms of Judge Alan Glenn and Judge Ross Hicks will expire on December 31, 2019. The Court wishes to recognize Judge Glenn and Judge Hicks for their valued service and outstanding contribution as members of the Judicial Ethics Committee. We further commend Judge Glenn for his many years of exemplary service as Chair of the committee. To replace Judge Glenn as the Judge from the Court of Appeals or Court of Criminal Appeals, the Court is pleased to appoint Judge Ross Dyer for a term expiring December 31, 2023. To replace Judge Hicks as the trial judge from Middle Tennessee, the Court is pleased to appoint Judge Jill Ayers for a term expiring December 31, 2023.
