ORDER

The Tennessee Supreme Court is authorized pursuant to T.C.A. § 8-21-501 to set the amount of court costs and other fees that the Clerk of the Supreme Court ("Clerk")—who also serves as Clerk of the Court of Appeals, the Court of Criminal Appeals, and the Board of Judicial Conduct—may charge for the services provided by the Clerk's office.

On July 9, 2018, the Clerk intends to implement a new electronic filing system. The rules and procedures compiled by this Court in preparation for the implementation of this new system necessitate a simpler method for charging costs and fees by the Clerk. A study and review of costs and fees charged by the Clerk reflects that the costs and fees set out in the Appendix to this Order are reasonable and will permit the Clerk to continue to meet his obligations in accordance with prior budgetary practices.

Pending further order of the Court, the Supreme Court hereby adopts the schedule of costs and fees set out in the Appendix to this Order which is incorporated herein by reference.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that beginning on July 9, 2018 and until further order of the Court, the Clerk shall charge the costs and fees for the Clerk's services as set out in the Appendix to this Order. In addition to the costs and fees listed in the Appendix, the Clerk may continue to charge all fees or charges otherwise authorized by statute or rule.
