This letter is written in regards to my objection to the potential redistricting of the 29th Judicial District.

I do not feel the citizens of these counties will be in favor of redistricting the 29th Judicial District and I, as County Mayor, do not feel it would be in the best interest of our County. Citizens here, by nature alone, do not accept change of any sort. They are used to going to certain offices and dealing with people they are familiar with, when seeking help, for whatever problem they may have. Our county government affiliated offices have wonderful working relationships with each other, as the citizens are well aware. In addition, the office holders know where to direct someone, whom may need help from another entity.

Judges, Law Enforcement, and the Clerk's office are easily obtainable, and have good working relationships with each other. I can honestly say that the Chancellor, Judges, District Attorney and respective staffs of the courts and offices which make up the 29th Judicial District all work together in an efficient and professional manner which puts service to the legal community, law enforcement and those who use the court system at first priority. They are always available locally for any potential emergency situation that may arise. There are often situations where someone's life may be in danger, potentially a child's wellbeing or otherwise, and being able to obtain the proper signatures for Orders can literally be a life or death matter.

I am strongly opposed to redistricting of the 29th Judicial District. I do not feel this would be in the best interest of our area.
