Only those candidates who have taken an approved Ethics & Skill Building Workshop on record with the AOC are eligible to sit for the written examination. If you have previously taken the examination, six (6) months must have elapsed between your previous testing session. 1. Positive photo identification – This must be either a United States government-issued driver's license or passport. If you do not possess either of these, contact Ryan Mouser at (615) 741-2687 prior to the deadline.

You will not have access to any of your personal belongings during the exam. If you will be in need of medication during the exam, please make arrangements with the proctor prior to starting the exam or make a note on your application form.

Please note that your examination scores, as well as all the other information in the Court Interpreter Credentialing Program's records, are considered public records under state law and are subject to disclosure upon the request of a member of the public. The AOC will send you a letter of admission confirming your scheduled testing session.
