

ORDER

On September 7, 2016, the Court filed an order soliciting public comments on proposed amendments to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 19 to eliminate a potential conflict between Rule 7, section 5.01(g)(8) and Rule 19 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court. The order set Monday, October 10, 2016, as the deadline for submitting comments on the proposed amendments.

On September 28, 2016, the Knoxville Bar Association ("KBA") requested an extension of time to comment on the proposed amendments. After due consideration, the Court hereby grants the KBA's request. The deadline for submitting written comments on the proposed amendments is hereby extended until Thursday, November 10, 2016.

The Clerk shall provide a copy of this order to LexisNexis and to Thompson Reuters. In addition, this order shall be posted on the Tennessee Supreme Court's website.
