ORDER

Upon consideration of the applications for permission to appeal and the record before us, the applications of Clark Reliance Company, Jerguson Gage and Valve Division; Armstrong International, Inc.; DeZurik, Inc.; Flowserve Corporation f/k/a The Duriron Company, Inc.; Ingersoll-Rand Company; The William Powell Company; and Fisher Controls International, LLC are granted. The application of Neles-Jamesbury, Inc. and Metso Automation USA, Inc. is granted with respect to the third question presented for review, and denied with respect to the first and second questions presented for review. These applicants are collectively referred to as the "Equipment Defendants." The parties are directed to address the following issue:

Whether the Court of Appeals erred in holding that the Equipment Defendants had a duty to warn of the dangers associated with the post-sale integration of asbestos-containing materials manufactured and sold by others.

The applications of Daniel International Corporation and John Crane, Inc. are denied.

The Clerk of the Court is directed to place this matter on the docket for oral argument upon the completion of briefing.

STATE OF TENNESSEE v. YODELKIS CONTRERAS

ORDER

Upon consideration of the application for permission to appeal of Yodelkis Contreras and the record before us, the application is granted.

This cause shall be set for oral argument on the Court's May 28, 2020 docket in Nashville. No extensions of time for the filing of briefs in this matter will be allowed. In addition to the issues raised by Mr. Contreras, the Court requests that the parties address the following issues:

1) Whether Mr. Contreras's sentence had expired before the trial court revoked his probation.

2) Whether the general tolling provisions announced in *State v. Shaffer*, 45 S.W.3d 553 (Tenn. 2001), apply to the unique circumstances of this case in which the defendant was illegally placed on probation, the State had notice of the illegality and an opportunity to correct it but chose not to do so, and the State failed to serve the probation violation warrant even though the defendant was incarcerated.

Upon consideration of the application for permission to appeal of the State of Tennessee, ex. rel. Rachel Beth Haynes and the record before us, the application is denied.

The opinion of the Court of Appeals is designated "Not For Citation" in accordance with Supreme Court Rule 4, § E because of the Court of Appeals majority's constitutional analysis, which was unnecessary to the resolution of the appeal and, therefore, should not have been undertaken. See <u>Hancock v. Board of Professional</u> <u>Responsibility</u>, 447 S.W.3d 844, 45 (Tenn. 2014).

Upon consideration of the application for permission to appeal of Williamson County Schools and the record before us, the application is granted. Further, the Tennessee School Boards Association's motion for leave to file an amicus curiae brief in support of the Williamson County Schools' Rule 11 application is also granted.

SONYA P. WILLIAMS v. SHELBY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

Rule 23 Certified Question of Law from the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee

No. 217-cv-02050-TLP-jay

ORDER

Pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 23, a certification order was filed in this Court on November 7, 2019, by the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee. Briefs have now been filed pursuant to Section 7, and, upon consideration of the certification order and the briefs filed by the parties, this Court declines certification of the following questions of law:

- Is a teacher whose position was abolished and who was terminated from her employment with the school system due to a reduction in force under the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated § 49-5-511(b)(1)—(3) entitled to backpay damages when the school board fails to act as the final decision-maker on her termination as required by § 49-5-511(b)(1), or when the board does not provide the teacher notice under § 49-5-511(b)(2), or when the board does not place a qualified teacher on a reemployment list as provided for in § 49-5-511(b)(3)?
- 2) Is the Teacher Tenure Act, Tennessee Code Annotated § 49-5-511(b)(1), violated when the school board votes on the dismissal of teachers terminated under a reduction in force policy during a certain time frame, when some of those teachers' names are listed on the resolution but the plaintiff's name was not listed due to an error?
- 3) Are the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated § 49-5-511(b)(2)—(3), requiring "written notice of dismissal" and "place[ment] on a list for reemployment," mandatory or directory?

Further, the Motion to Strike Respondent's Reply Brief filed by Petitioner, Shelby County Board of Education is also denied.
