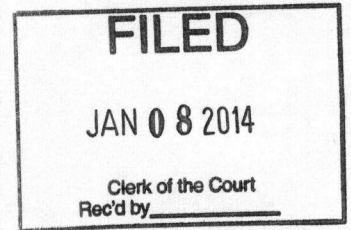

**IN RE: CLOSURE OF THE KNOXVILLE APPELLATE COURT CLERKS  
OFFICE DUE TO WATER MAIN BREAK RENDERING THE BUILDING  
UNINHABITABLE**

**ORDER**

On the afternoon of Wednesday, January 8, 2014, a water main broke leading to the Knoxville Supreme Court Building. Due to this break, the heating system for the building, which relies upon a water supply to heat, lost its ability to heat the building. This event has rendered the Knoxville Supreme Court Building temporarily uninhabitable until the water main is repaired, which will not be completed until Monday, January 13, 2014.

For the reasons stated above, and pursuant to Rule 21(a) of the Tennessee Rules of Appellate Procedure, it is ORDERED that the Knoxville Appellate Court Clerks Office shall be closed from Thursday, January 9, 2014, until Monday, January 13, 2014. Therefore, by operation of Rule 21(a), the time period prescribed for or allowed by the Rules of Appellate Procedure for filing any document due on either Thursday, January 9, 2014, or Friday, January 10, 2014, is extended to Monday, January 13, 2014.
