ORDER

By order dated November 16, 2018, this Court set the execution of Abu-Ali Abdur'Rahman for April 9, 2020. The order is hereby amended to re-set the execution for April 16, 2020.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Warden of the Riverbend Maximum Security Institution, or his designee, shall execute the sentence of death as provided by law on the 16th day of April 2020, unless otherwise ordered by this Court or other appropriate authority. No later than April 1, 2020, the Warden or his designee shall notify Mr. Abdur'Rahman of the method that the Tennessee Department of Correction (TDOC) will use to carry out the execution and of any decision by the Commissioner or TDOC to rely upon the Capital Punishment Enforcement Act.

Counsel for Mr. Abdur'Rahman shall provide a copy of any order staying execution of this order to the Office of the Clerk of the Appellate Court in Nashville. The Clerk shall expeditiously furnish a copy of any order of stay to the Warden of the Riverbend Maximum Security Institution.
