ORDER ON THE STATE'S MOTIONS IN LIMINE # 2 AND # 3

Before the Court are two motions in limine filed by the state on May 15, 2025. This Court addressed the motions from the bench on May 19, 2025.

Motion in limine # 2 seeks to exclude from the evidentiary hearing evidence not provided as reciprocal discovery under Rule 16. Counsel for the Petitioner stated that reciprocal discovery had been disclosed in full, with a possible exception for a developing matter. See Petitioner's Response to Motion in Limine 1-3, filed May 19, 2025. This Court determined that it would address the admissibility of subsequently arising or undisclosed facts, if any, at the time they occur.

Motion in limine # 3 seeks to exclude from the evidentiary hearing any evidence and testimony regarding polygraph and voice stress testing and results. Counsel for the Petitioner stated such evidence would not be introduced during the hearing. *See* Petitioner's Response to Motion in Limine 1-3, filed May 19, 2025. Accordingly, this motion is uncontested.
