**MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**  
**AND PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

Plaintiff Philip Workman hereby respectfully moves the Court under Fed. R. Civ. P. 65 to enter a Temporary Restraining Order in this case to preserve the status quo, staying and prohibiting his execution scheduled for 1 a.m. on March 20, 2001 until final determination of the merits of the issues in this case, the resolution of all appeals therefrom, and, if the action is successful, complete relief is granted.


As grounds for this Motion, Plaintiff relies on the Complaint, on the accompanying

Memorandum in Support of this Motion, on the Declarations and Sworn Affidavits and sworn testimony and other exhibits contemporaneously filed in the accompanying Appendix and other filings, on the entire record, and on the argument of counsel. Plaintiff further asks the Court, pursuant to Rule 65, Fed. R. Civ. P., to set a hearing on a forthcoming necessary Motion for Preliminary Injunction to extend the stay of his execution pendente lite, and to set the security required by Rule 65 at zero due to Plaintiff's incarcerated circumstances and indigent status.




