2 to 3 minutes before returning to his vehicle. Mr. Kenny indicated that he balieved that this party whom he had described, was responsible for the hold-up. It was later determined by the writer that the person Mr. Kenny described was actually the clean up man, who was inside the building at the time of the bold-up. Mr. Kenny saw the clean up man sitting at a table inside Wendy's waiting to be interviewed by Sgt. R. K. Wilson and did say that the person appeared to be the same one that he had seen at the time he tried the door.

I then talked to Eva Sue Kenny, who accompanied her husband to the door and stood to the east of Mr. Kenny while he tried the door. Mrs. Kenny said she paid no attention to the person kneeling in the vestibule but that she did see a M/N cating at a table in the extreme morth east corner of the Wendy's building. She described this H/W as being in his late 30's to early 40's with a light colored baseball type cap and a light shirt. Mrs. Kenny said she paid no particular attention to this person and did not believe that she would be able to recognize him again, should she see him.

I then talked to Nikki Wood, F/W, 932 Brad #1, home phone 353-4129, who said she accompanied " Mr. and Hrs. Kenny to Wendy's and that she saw the person in the vestibule describing him as a H/W with a puggy face dressed in a blue cap and blue jacket. Ms. Wood was apparently describing the same clean-up person which mr. Kenny had earlier described.

I then talked to Jeff Rickard, M/W, 19, 1842 St. Elmo, home phone 358-1429, where addised that he was at the Corner Grocery at Thomas and Frayser Blvd, and that there were the final the first for the first for the first for the said the two police cars, which were on the lot at the Grocery, immediately pulled toward the sound of the shooting and that he jumped in his car and followed them. He said that so soon as he turned the corner, he saw a M/W with dark clothes with a cap on, approximately $5^{10^{\circ}}$ and 140 to 155 lbs, carrying a chrome colored pistol run north in front of the Holiday Auto Parts, which is the first business north of Wandy's. He said this M/W appeared to be holding his bed with his right hand while running. He said that he did not believe that he would be able to identify this person if he saw him again. He said he did not witness the actual shooting but that he did see the officers lying on the parking lot area.

It may be noted while talking to Jeff Rickard, the writer heard the dispatcher put out information that the suspect was in the weeded area behind Holiday Auto Parts and notified several cars to pull into that area. I stopped my conversation with Rickard and began to go toward the area where I could see flashlights and hear a commotion. I heard one of the cars say that the suspect was under arrest and I returned to finish the interview with Jeff Rickard. Shortly after finishing this interview, I was instructed by Lt. Keenan to report to John Gaston to attempt to obtain information from the arrested party who had been taken

I proceeded to Joha Gaston Emergency Room, arriving there at approximately 0030 hours. There were numerous media and police personnel on the scene and efter entering the Emergency Room. I talked to Lt. J. O. Mamby who advised that the suspect had possibly been shot and was in the trauma section of the Emergency Room. He accompanied de to this section, where I first gaw the M/W suspect. Later learned to be Larry Wilson. Wilson was lying on his stomach with the rear portion of his pants ripped and I could see several scretches and dog bites on the Johar portion of the body. The doctor's aids were cutting the blue jeans off of his person. A gown was being put over the upper portion of his body. When he was turned over, I moticed a considerable amount of blood on the facial area and on the upper torso area. I ested the doctor who was treating him, who I learned to be Dr. Fred Moore, if I could talk to the suspect and attempt to determine whether or not he was the party responsible for the hold.
