Forfeiture Warrant Hearing Requirements by Factual Scenario

TCA 40-33-204

ALWAYS REQ'D:

Documents:

-Notice of Seizure ("NOS") -Forfeiture Warrant ("FW") -Affidavit in Support of FW -Narrative (which is both submitted to court and read into the record)

REQ'D BY SCENARIO:

SCENARIO 1 PIP is arrested AND <u>ALL</u> known potential owners are present at the time of seizure

<u>Deadline</u>: FW hearing within <u>5 business days</u> of the date of seizure. 10 day extension under §40-33-204(c)(2) permissible.

Documents: NOFWH not required.

Testimony: Must be ex parte.

Testimony:

Solely questions by Judge to determine probable cause. Officer will always testify. Can be any officer present at seizure (not initial encounter).

SCENARIO 2 PIP is NOT arrested AND <u>ALL</u> potential owners are present at the time of seizure

<u>Deadline</u>: FW hearing must take place within a "reasonable time." No extension.

<u>Documents</u>: NOFWH(s) must be submitted.

<u>Testimony</u>: PIP is allowed to testify, but potential owners are not.

Checkboxes:

If there is a *registered owner other than PIP*, shall ask officer the checkbox questions and affirm on the FW. (§40-33-204(e))

SCENARIO 3 PIP is arrested AND <u>ALL</u> potential owners are <u>NOT</u> present at the time of seizure

<u>Deadline</u>: FW hearing must take place within <u>45 regular days</u> of the date of seizure. No extension.

Documents: NOFWH(s) must be submitted.

<u>Testimony</u>: PIP and any potential owners *not present* at time of seizure are allowed to testify. SHALL record the FW Hearing and SHALL maintain said audio recording.

Recording:

SCENARIO 4 PIP is NOT arrested AND <u>ALL</u> potential owners are <u>NOT</u> present at the time of seizure

Deadline: FW hearing must take place within <u>45 regular days</u> of the date of seizure. No extension.

Documents: NOFWH(s) must be submitted.

<u>Testimony</u>: PIP and any potential owners *not present* at time of seizure are allowed to testify.

MISC. NOTES:

If PIP and/or potential owners do not attend, FW Hearing shall be *ex parte*. Your ruling can only issue FW, deny FW, or grant 10 day extension under §204(c)(2). Counsel may attend (unless *ex parte*) but MAY NOT present evidence or participate in the hearing.

Key:

PIP = Person in Possession

FW = Forfeiture Warrant

NOS = Notice of Seizure

NOFWH = Notice of Forfeiture Warrant Hearing
