

CONFERENCE INFORMATION

The spring and summer Clerks of Court Conference seminars are scheduled for **May 13-15**, **2015**, at the Sheraton Music City in Nashville and **June 17-19**, **2015**, at the Sheraton, Downtown Memphis.

We encourage the attendance and participation of deputy clerks at the spring & summer seminars. These seminars are planned with the deputy clerk in mind as well as the appointed/elected clerks. These seminars are an invaluable opportunity to have deputy clerks involved in discussions thus giving attendees a better understanding of the topics presented.

REGISTRATION

For your convenience, you may register online at www.tncourts.gov; Go to the "Administration" page, click "Continuing Legal Education" then choose "Clerks of Court Conference," password is *justice*, or fax the completed form to (615) 532-9818 or (615) 741-6285, Attention: Caitlin Goellnitz or caitlin.goellnitz@tncourts.gov.

The maximum number of **clerks** and **deputy clerks** who may attend from a clerk's office is determined by **T.C.A.** '8-24-101 and '18-1-504. The "maximum number of clerks who may attend" means the <u>combined total for both the May and June seminars</u>. Per the above-mentioned code, <u>only clerks and deputy clerks may attend each seminar</u>.

Please attend the seminar location closest to you. If you are traveling five hours or more from your home county office to the conference and wish to travel to the conference the day before it begins, you may request reimbursement from the AOC for lodging and mileage for the travel day. You must notify Caitlin Goellnitz when you submit your registration form, if you intend on arriving early.

For those of you traveling **less than five hours** from your home county office to the conference and choosing to travel to the conference the day before it begins, the AOC will **not** reimburse you for travel costs for the day before the conference begins. **You** will be responsible for the cost of your **lodging and per diem** for this travel day. Additionally, you **CANNOT** reserve your hotel for the night of the travel day under the AOC's hotel room block and therefore will **NOT** be guaranteed a hotel room. **You must notify Caitlin Goellnitz if you intend on arriving early.**

Once you have registered for the conference you should receive a confirmation memo. This usually takes one to two weeks. If you do not receive a confirmation, please contact the AOC to ensure your registration was received.

ROOM RESERVATIONS

The AOC will make room reservations with each hotel. The cut-off date is Monday, April 6, 2015. Accommodations are available on a first-come, first-served basis. *Please return the attached registration form(s) no later than Monday, April 6, 2015.*

PLEASE NOTE: Cancellations less than 48 hours prior to check-in, or no-shows, will result in you being charged for one night's room rate. Currently, each hotel is charging an early departure fee to any guest who checks out of the hotel before their stated departure date. However, guests will have the opportunity to change their departure date at check-in without being assessed a fee. Attendees are responsible for paying any incidental charges upon their departure. **Please check your arrival and departure dates on the confirmation memo carefully.**

PER DIEM

Additionally, you will NOT be permitted to reserve a room under the AOC hotel room block and therefore will not be guaranteed a hotel room. The AOC will NOT reimburse per diem.
