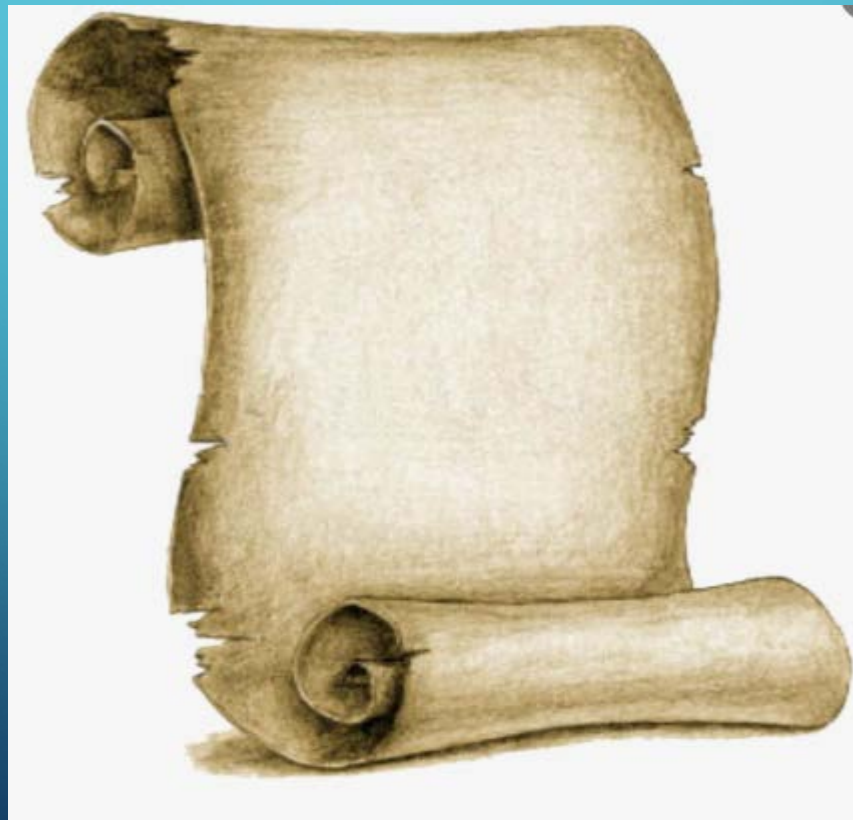





Process before floor presentation


- Filing of the Bill with the Clerk's office & numbering
- Introduction on 1st reading (done during floor session)
- Pass on 2nd Consideration and Assigned to Committee




