

TnCIS?*

-

- Replacement of legacy code that requires Internet Explorer and Active X.
  - Automated TCA updates (this has already been deployed). Currently, TCA Codes are automatically updated every night for all the sites.

*The following will be in the form of a new release or update in TnCIS*

- List Search Enhancements (the ability to filter and sort search lists by available columns)
- E-filing enhancements resulting in more automation and less manual entries. A criminal portion will be added also.
- Removal of MS Word as a requirement for TnCIS documents (may be subject to change)... Will work with any application that uses open.xml format
- Rewriting and updating database structures and service endpoints to improve performance.



- An eventual overhaul of the jointly/severally process. This will not be included in initial roll out.
- A process to export bound over cases from general sessions to circuit court removing manual data entry that is currently required.
- Party search enhancements, including researching the possibility of a name search across databases (GS and CC name search).
- Juvenile court product - Juvenile requirements changed last year, this would provide the additional fields for state reporting and create the file to be submitted to Quest for state juvenile reporting
