AGREED ORDER OF ADJUDICATION

This came on before this court on the ____ day of _____, ____ for adjudication on the Petition for Court Ordered Services and to Adjudicate this child Dependent and Neglected, filed by the Tennessee Department of Children's Services. The parties agreed to and the Court hereby accepts the following findings:

1. The court finds based upon the stipulation of the parties, that there is clear and convincing evidence to adjudicate the children dependent and neglected as defined in TCA 37-1-102(b). The factual basis stipulated to by the Respondents is as alleged in the petition due to the allegation in the _____, 20__ petition filed by DCS as follows:

2. At this time, the Mother is in compliance with the requirements of DCS including:

3. At this time, the Father has failed to make any contact with DCS or have any contact with the children.

4. Supervised visitation between the Mother and the children has continued on a regular basis as ordered with no issues.
5. It is in the best interest of the children to have unsupervised visitation with their Mother so long as she remains compliant with her treatment.

The terms of this order are found to be in the best interests of the children pending further hearings.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

1. Temporary custody of _____ and _____ is granted unto the children's paternal grandparents, _____, who shall have the authority to make decisions concerning the children's health, education and welfare subject to further orders of this court.
2. Mother, _____, shall have unsupervised visitation with the children at times as agreed upon between Mother and the paternal grandparents. Mother shall be allowed unsupervised visitation as long as she continues the recommended treatment through Centerstone.
3. Father's visitation shall be suspended until such time as he shall establish compliance with the requirements of DCS.
