MOTION TO ASSUME JURISDICTION, OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE MOTION TO VACATE STAY

The defendants-appellants respectfully request this Court to assume jurisdiction of this Rule 9, T.R.A.P. appeal. In support of this motion, the defendants-appellants would show that the trial court has set aside this Court's order directing Robert Glen Coe's execution on April 19, 2000.
