MOTION FOR STAY PENDING APPEAL

Came the Petitioner, Robert Glen Coe, and pursuant to FED.R.CIV.P. 62 and 7TH CIR.C.
81651 & 2251 and respectfully moves this Court to stay this Court's March 24, 2000 order
dismissing his petition for writ of habeas corpus and dissolving the previously entered stay of
execution. This Court should grant the stay pending appeal, because: (1) Robert Coe will suffer
irreparable harm if the order is not stayed; (2) the state has no interest in executing the inmate; (3)
the public has no interest in the execution of the inmate; (4) the harm to the state is minimal; and (5)
there is a substantial likelihood that Robert Coe will be successful on his appeal, given, *inter alia*,
that the state court never addressed his competency, underexercised mitigation strategy; failed to
apply the proper common law standard governing his claims, and denied him a full and fair
consideration of his claims through the numerous procedural irregularities occurring during the state
court proceedings, including the adjudication of his claims by a judge whose life was threatened if
he failed in Robert Coe's favor. Under these circumstances, Robert Coe has shown likely success on
the merits of his appeal, and the motion for stay should therefore be granted. The status quo prior
to the entry of the order — with a stay of execution granted to Robert Coe — should be maintained
pending the final disposition of the appeal in the Sixth Circuit.
