## **MOTION TO REASSIGN CASE**

Plaintiff hereby moves the Court to reassign this case. This case appears to have been assigned pursuant to Administrative Order No. 158 ("the Order), which by its own terms, applies to Capital Habeas Corpus petitions. This case, by contrast, is a civil action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 1983 and 1985(3) and pendent state civil claims.

Counsel for Plaintiff orally advised the Clerk of the Court, Mr. Milam, of Plaintiff's position as described above, and requested to "be heard" by the Court immediately on the incorrect assignment issue, because this case is so time-sensitive and there is an outstanding request for emergency TRO. Mr. Milam advised that he would carry this request to the Chief Judge, and shortly returned to report that the Judge could not hear this issue until the morning, at least.

Plaintiff respectively seeks both an immediate hearing on this issue, tonight if possible,

and once resolved on the Motion for a TRO.
