Dear Chief Clerks:

Please find enclosed the statistical report of the Board of Judicial Conduct covering filings and dispositions for the month of August, 2012, along with a cumulative year-to-date total, as mandated by Tenn. Code Ann. § 17-5-207(a)(1), due September 20, 2012.

Tenn. Code Ann. § 17-5-207(b) also mandates that by "the twentieth day of January, March, June and September of each year, the board shall compile and transmit to the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and Chief Clerk of the Senate" a report containing certain information "for the prior three (3) month period." As the Board was not in existence during the last quarter, not having been created by the legislature until July 1, 2012, there is no statistical information from the Board of Judicial Conduct available for that period. In its stead, the final annual report of the Court of Judiciary, the organization that handled complaints for that quarter, has been posted on our website at <u>http://www.tncourts.gov/court-judiciary</u> as the final act of the Court of the Judiciary, closing out that fiscal year.
