MOTION FOR STAY OF EXECUTION

In his petition for writ of certiorari, Petitioner Robert Glen Coe has presented substantial and weighty issues concerning the meaning and application of *Ford v. Wainwright*, 477 U.S. 399 (1986) in the context of the AEDPA's standard of review under 28 U.S.C. §2254(d). Those issues are worthy of further review in this Court and certiorari is warranted, in this, Robert Coe's initial habeas petition presenting his *Ford* claims. For all the reasons stated in his petition for writ of certiorari, this Court should grant a stay of execution pending the final disposition of the petition for certiorari. *Barefoot v. Estelle*, 463 U.S. 890, 893-894 (1983); *See Williams v. Taylor*, U.S. No. 98-8384 (cert. pending), stay granted 119 S.Ct. 1355 (1999); *Taylor v. Cain*, U.S. No. 99-6035 (cert. pending), stay granted 120 S.Ct. 31 (1999).
