ORDER

Robert Glen Coe has filed a Petition for a Writ of *Habeas Corpus* with this court. It has been determined to be unrelated to his previous federal *habeas corpus* proceeding, Case No. 3:92-0180. Therefore, it may constitute a "second or successive application" under 28 U.S.C. § 2244(b)(3)(A), which provides as follows:

Before a second or successive application permitted by this section is filed in the district court, the applicant shall move in the appropriate court of appeals for an order authorizing the district court to consider the application.


It is therefore **ORDERED** that the parties shall brief this threshold issue by noon on March 17, 2000. Petitioner's counsel may reply to the respondent's brief by 3:00 p.m. on March 17, 2000.

Leave is hereby granted to the respondent to file responses to any of the other motions filed by the petitioner on March 16, 2000.

Copies of all filings in this case shall be furnished to opposing counsel contemporaneously with their filing, either by hand delivery or facsimile copy.
