ORDER

Currently pending before the Court is Petitioner's Statement in Support of This Court's Jurisdiction Over Petitioner's Initial Habcas Petition in which Petitioner asks this Court to: (1) address unresolved claims in his original habeas corpus petition concerning the effect of <u>Brady</u> violations on his capital sentencing hearing and the constitutionality of the reasonable doubt instructions given at the sentencing phase of his trial; (2) reconsider its denial of a prior motion to include a claim challenging the constitutionality of electrocution and to permit such an amendment at this time; and (3) permit amendment of the original habeas petition to include a claim raising the issue of Petitioner's present incompetency to be executed under <u>Ford v. Wainright</u>, 477 U.S. 399 (1986). (Doc. No. 434.) In addition, Petitioner has filed a Motion to Disqualify Attorney General Paul G. Summers and the Office of the Attorney General. (Doc. No. 436.)

In accordance with the reasoning set forth in the contemporaneously entered Memorandum, the Court hereby DENIES Petitioner's Statement and the Motions to Amend and to Consider Unresolved Claims included therein. Accordingly, the Court hereby DISMISSES without prejudice Petitioner's Motion to Disqualify as MOOT.
