ORDER GRANTING STATE'S MOTION FOR COURT APPOINTMENT AND PAYMENT OF STATE'S MENTAL HEALTH EXPERTS

IT APPEARS TO THE COURT: that in its order setting defendant Coc's execution date, filed December 15, 1999, the Tennessee Supreme Court also held that the defendant had raised the issue of his competency to be executed. Accordingly, the Tennessee Supreme Court remanded the issue of competency to this Court for proceedings in accordance with <u>Van Tran v. State</u>. The Court also set December 29, 1999 as the deadline for the defendant to file his petition.

In order to be prepared to timely meet all future deadlines under the procedure set out in <u>Van_Tran</u>, this Court has asked both parties to designate their respective mental bealth professionals and declare their fees. The State of Tennessee requests that Daniel A. Martell, Ph.D., and Daryl Brace Matthews, M.D., Ph.D., of Park E. Dietz and Associates, 537 Newport Center Drive, Suite 300, Newport Beach, California, 92660, be appointed to serve as it's mental health professionals, and be compensated by the Court, during the course of these competency

proceedings. The fee charged by both is \$300/hour for time spent both in or out of court. Time spent out of Newport Beach, California area is charges as a ten (10) hour day. This includes travel time and time spent performing any evaluations, waiting to testify and testifying. The Court

finds that the request of the State is well taken and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED: that Daniel A. Martell, Ph.D., and Daryl Bruce Matthews, M.D., Ph.D., of Park E. Dietz and Associates, 537 Newport Center Drive, Suite 300, Newport Beach, California, 92660, be appointed to serve as the State of Tennessee's mental health professionals in the evaluation of Robert Glen Coe, and be compensated by the Coart, during the course of these competency proceedings according to the fee schedule above.
