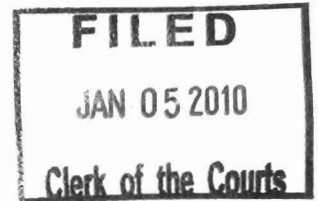



AGREED ORDER SETTING FOR TRIAL


