JUDICIAL REFERRAL FROM FOSTER CARE REVIEW BOARD

The foster care review board may make a **direct referral** to the court, including its findings and recommendations, under two circumstances:

1. When issues in the case present risk of harm and **directly compromise the health, safety or welfare of child.** Referral must be heard by the judge/ magistrate within **72 hours** excluding non-judicial days. 2. When conditions persist that interfere with permanency goals and these conditions indirectly or chronically compromise the health, safety or welfare of child. Referral must be heard by the judge/ magistrate within 30 calendar days. T.C.A. §§37-2-406(c)(1); TRJP 403(i)

The FCRB determines when a referral is required, the FCRB facilitator decides whether the referral is a 72 hour referral or a 30 day referral. The facilitator will update the FCRB volunteers at the next scheduled meeting.
