ORDER

Supreme Court Rule 37(j)(2)(A) sets out the procedure for remanding a workers' compensation appeal to the trial court for that court's consideration of a settlement agreement reached on all issues as the result of mediation. In order to conform that procedure with the Court's internal procedures for the disposition of motions, the Court hereby amends Rule 37(j)(2)(A) by deleting the current subparagraph in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

(A) **Agreement about all issues.** If mediation results in an agreement on all of the issues on appeal, parties' counsel shall file in the Supreme Court a motion to remand the case to the trial court for approval of the settlement and providing for the payment of costs in the case.

This amendment shall be effective upon the filing of this order.
