ORDER

On October 4, 2024, in response to the severe flooding and resulting impact of Hurricane Helene, the Tennessee Supreme Court activated and promulgated a limited disaster plan under Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 49, section 2 for all the trial courts in the First, Second, Third, and Fourth Judicial Districts. The Court extended mandatory filing deadlines contained in the Tennessee Rules of Civil Procedure, the Tennessee Rules of Criminal Procedure, the Tennessee Rules of Juvenile Practice and Procedure, the Tennessee Rules of Appellate Procedure, and other applicable court rules until November 12, 2024. The Court also extended statutes of limitations, statutes or response, orders or protection, and temporary injunctions that would otherwise expire between the period of September 26 and November 12, 2024 through November 12, 2024.

In light of ongoing concerns and consistent with the extended deadlines contained in the Governor’s Executive Order No. 107, the Court hereby continues the provisions of its October 4, 2024 order. All mandatory deadlines under the aforementioned rules of practice and procedure, and statutes of limitations, statutes of repose, orders of protection, and temporary injunctions that were extended through November 12, 2024 are hereby extended through December 25, 2024.

It is so ORDERED.
