

## UPCOMING MOTION DOCKETS FOR JUDGE WOODRUFF AND JUDGE BINKLEY CIVIL AND DOMESTIC

During the suspension of in-person court proceedings, motions scheduled on the motion dockets for Judge Woodruff and Judge Binkley may be heard telephonically provided:

1. Both parties agree
2. Both parties are in strict compliance with Local Rule 5.03 (a) and (c)
3. The hearing will be less than a total of 40 minutes
4. The hearing will be for argument only, no testimony
5. Give notice to the judge's assistant by email no later than 5:00 PM on the close of business on Tuesday before the Thursday docket.

The judge's assistant will then email you with instructions regarding the time and accessing the hearing on your scheduled Thursday docket day.
