## COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE UNDER THE CODE OF JUDICIAL CONDUCT

Important: The Board of Judicial Conduct is not an appeals court and does not have the authority to review, revise, or correct a judge's decision or ruling in any case whether civil or criminal. Examples include granting or denying a motion, setting bond, admitting or excluding evidence, weighing the evidence, assessing the credibility of witnesses, or interpreting and applying the law. Any such actions taken by a judge must be appealed to an appellate court through the legal process. The Board also cannot address allegations of misconduct involving attorneys, court clerks, jail staff, or law enforcement officers.
