

NOTICE OF JUDICIAL VACANCY

Circuit Court 29th Judicial District Dyer and Lake Counties

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Annotated § 17-4-308(d), notice is hereby given that the Court Vacancy Commission will meet on Thursday, November 4, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. CDT in the 29th Judicial District to initiate the process of filling an upcoming vacancy occurring December 1, 2021 as a result of the retirement of the Honorable Russell Lee Moore. The exact location of the hearing will be determined and announced soon.

Applicants must be an attorney licensed in Tennessee who is at least 30 years of age, a resident of the state for five (5) years, and must reside in the Judicial District. Applicants must submit a completed application (*Trial Court Vacancy Commission Application*). Applications must be submitted to the Administrative Office of the Courts no later than **Friday, October 8, 2021 at 12:00 p.m. CDT**. The Commission encourages all candidates to submit applications as soon as possible.

Applicants must submit by the deadline: (1) the original signed (unbound) application; and (2) a digital copy of the application, in order to have his/her name placed on the list of candidates for consideration for the judicial vacancy for which he/she is applying. The Commission is committed to encouraging a diverse judiciary and welcomes all qualified attorneys to apply for judicial vacancies.

Any member of the public may attend the public hearing to express, orally or in writing, objections concerning applicant(s) for the judicial vacancy.
