Should counsel subpoena an incarcerated witness, the procedures set forth in the "Court Trial Procedures for Jury Trials" shall be followed. All subpoenas will be issued within fourteen (14) days. Any problems with regarding attendance of witnesses must be brought to the Court's attention immediately. Failure to comply will not result in a continuance of the trial.
7. Counsel has read the Division III "Trial Procedures for Jury Cases" and agrees to abide by these procedures.
8. Defense counsel affirms that Defendant has been informed of the above-noted trial and status dates and is aware that all plea offers may be withdrawn now that the case is set for trial.
