Rule 13 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court is hereby amended by adding the following language to the end of Section 4(d)(6) of the current rule:
If the court finds that these maximum rates are inadequate to secure the services of a qualified interpreter in a language other than Spanish, the court shall make written findings regarding such inadequacy and determine a reasonable maximum rate for a qualified interpreter.
