ORDER

The Tennessee General Sessions Judges Conference (“GSJC”) has filed a petition stating that a committee of the GSJC, in consultation with and assistance from members of the Creditors’ Practice Section of the Tennessee Bar Association and representatives of the Court Clerks, has created a set of uniform civil case forms for use in Tennessee’s General Sessions Courts. The GSJC has submitted the proposed forms as Exhibit A to its petition and asks this Court to approve these forms “as universally acceptable and legally sufficient for use in civil cases before the General Sessions Courts in Tennessee.”

The Court hereby publishes for public comment the Commission’s petition, including the proposed forms, set out in the attached Appendix. The Court solicits written comments from the Tennessee Access to Justice Commission, judges, lawyers, bar organizations, members of the public, and any other interested parties. The deadline for submitting written comments is October 26, 2011. Written comments should be addressed to:
