Rule 12 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee is hereby amended by deleting the second paragraph of Section 2 in its entirety and substituting in its place the following:

Rule 12, Section 2, second paragraph:

Prior to the setting of oral argument, the Court shall review the record and briefs and consider <u>all</u> errors assigned. The Court may enter an order designating those issues it wishes addressed at oral argument. The order shall afford the parties additional time for the filing of any supplemental briefs addressing these issues. In all cases, the Court will conduct the review as mandated by Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-13-206(c)(1).
