ORDER

After due consideration by the Court, it is ORDERED that Rule 27 of the Tennessee Supreme Court is hereby amended to delete from the first sentence of § 6.03(4) the words “any incumbent appellate judge who has filed a declaration of candidacy to seek election or re-election to a full eight (8) year term,” and to substitute the words “all appellate judges.” As amended §6.03(4) shall read as follows:

The committee shall provide the Judicial Evaluation Commission with a tabulation of all survey responses with regard to all appellate judges, except survey responses on pilot programs. The Judicial Evaluation Commission shall treat the tabulations of the survey responses used in preparing its evaluation and final report pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 17-4-201 as confidential.
