Rule 9, Section 6.1 is amended by deleting Section 6.1 in its entirety

and substituting in its place the following:

6.1 The Supreme Court shall appoint one hearing committee within each disciplinary district. Each district shall consist of not less than five members, nor more than thirty members of the Bar of this State who maintain an office for the practice of law within that district. Members of hearing committees may be recommended by the Board of Professional Responsibility, or the President or Board of Directors of the local bar associations in each district.
