

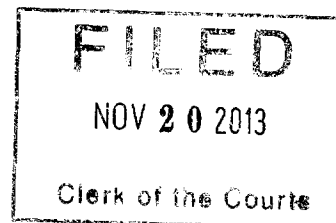

**ORDER**

Pursuant to Section 12.01 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 7, members of the Board of Law Examiners serve three-year terms. The Court has now determined that it is in the best interest of the Board to create term limits for Board members. Therefore, the Court hereby deletes the existing language of Section 12.01 and substitutes the following:

The Board shall consist of five attorneys licensed to practice law in this State and in good standing. The Board members shall be appointed to three-year terms by the Court. No member who has served three successive three-year terms shall be eligible for reappointment to the Board until three years after the termination of the most recent term.

The Clerk shall provide a copy of this Order to LexisNexis and to Thomson Reuters/West. In addition, this Order shall be posted on the Tennessee Supreme Court's website.
