

**ORDER**



On November 18, 2013, this Court published for public comment the October 30, 2013 petition to amend Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 21 filed by the Tennessee Commission on Continuing Legal Education and Specialization (“Commission”). We set the deadline for public comment as March 20, 2014.

On February 21, 2014, the Tennessee Bar Association (“TBA”) filed a motion asking this Court to extend the public comment deadline to May 21, 2014. The TBA states that the extension is necessary to address the broad and complex proposed amendments. The TBA also points out that the extended deadline would coincide with the public comment deadline set for a separate petition the Commission filed on January 3, 2014, which also proposes amendments to Rule 21.<sup>1</sup>

Upon due consideration, the TBA’s motion is GRANTED. The deadline for submitting public comments on the Commission’s October 30, 2013 petition is extended to May 21, 2014. Written comments should be addressed to:

<sup>1</sup> In the January 3, 2014 petition the Commission proposed to amend Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 21 by deleting the current language of section 10 in its entirety and substituting new language set out in the petition. This proposal related to current Rule 21, section 10, not to the re-designated section 10 proposed by the Commission’s October 30, 2013 petition. The January 3, 2014 petition also proposed amendments to Rule 21, section 1.01 and to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 8, RPC 7.4(d), as well as Comment [3] to RPC 7.4. On January 24, 2014, we published the January 3, 2014 petition for public comment and set the comment deadline as May 21, 2014. Comments regarding the January 3, 2014 petition should reference docket number ADM2014-00012.
